**David:** "It was tough, but I was pumped with adrenaline. You got tired, but it didn't matter. It all came together so well."

**David:** "They're both artists, good guys. Benicio is a loner whereas Cristian is always finding himself in one mess or another. Trouble seems to follow him."

**Amy:** Now's your chance! If you could only say one sentence to lure your fans to see your new film, what would your slogan be?

**David:** "Come hang out at the beach for two hours!"
